After 17 years of organizing over 60 ACMC Regional and National Conferences, I am thrilled to share with you that after the demise of Initiative 360 (which was the merger of ACMC and Caleb Project) the Lord guided me to continue serving the churches of Northern California with 'the Harvest Group' (a 501c3 Non-profit Ministry), which organizes the Perspectives courses in this region. My old ACMC Conferences are now positioned to be a new greater impact event because it is a combination of both the ACMC and Perspectives movements in Northern California / Nevada.

You are invited to participate in the "**Harvest Gathering of Churches for God's greatest Glory**" by having a display table to acquaint church leaders and Perspectives alumni with the latest information about your ministry. The Harvest Gathering is strategically organized to reach the most missions-oriented churches and their leadership at one single place and time. We have scheduled almost eight hours of "Exhibit Time" for delegates to interact with the exhibits during this "two-day" event.

Date: **April 30 & May 1, 2010**

Fee: **\$100 for the exhibit fee.** All exhibit personnel also pay the regular delegate registration rate:
Delegate fee - ***\$75 (4 or more from your agency only \$60 each)** - See brochure for more details

*** Subtract \$20 per person if registered prior to March 30th.**
Estimated Attendance 400 – 600 people (90-250 Churches represented)

We will have as part of our program, a workshop session called "Windows To The World", a forum for you to share for 12 minutes the exact focus and strategy of your ministry to a classroom of church missions leaders and to have an open question and answer period. Also on the space application form, include a short single-sentence question, with a one to four word answer. The question will be put before the delegates at the conference in a contest. This contest is designed to spark delegate's interest in your ministry and will encourage them to visit your exhibit in search of the answer.

Your exhibit fee covers: One 8-foot display table Participation in "Windows To The World"
 Exhibit Question contest Conference materials - Meals

We encourage your missionaries on furlough to gain current local church missions training and also to connect with missions leaders of multiple churches simultaneously, which may also expedite success in their deputation.

Please return to the Harvest Group address above the space application and check made out to the Harvest Group by April 2nd to reserve your space and be listed in the Conference handout package. The best positions will be assigned according to receipt of your paid application and needs requested on your space application form. The postmark of your returned application will determine final space placement.

Prior to April 10th, kindly send us a one-page 8½" x 11" handout about your ministry. We need a quantity of 600 that will be inserted into the conference binders. Please keep in mind that these 8½" x 11" inserts are included as a free benefit for exhibiting and please do not three-hole-punch the inserts. If you are sending us folded brochures instead, then it will cost an extra twenty-five cents per insert that will be placed in the inside cover sleeve. If you wish to **sponsor the outside back cover** of all the conference binders, it will cost **seventy-five cents per binder distributed**. Call me to discuss this.
